Prep 2 - Monday - 1:35 - 2:30 (week 1) THIS WILL COMMENCE MONDAY 26TH SEPTEMBER

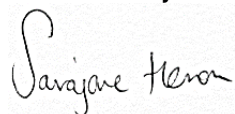
Prep 4 - Friday - 1:35 - 2.30 (week 2) THIS WILL COMMENCE ON FRIDAY 7TH OCTOBER
