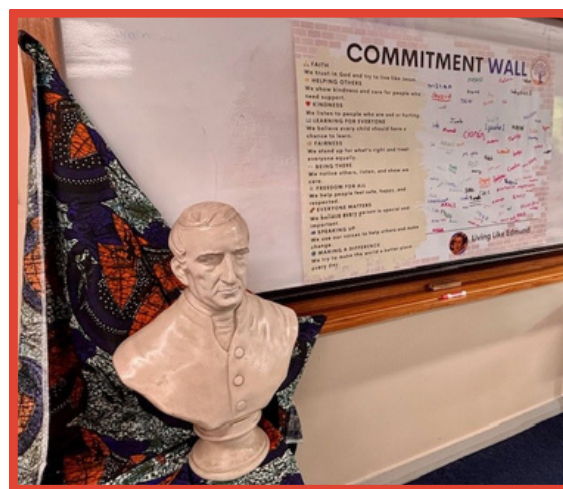

O God, we thank you for the life of Edmund Rice.

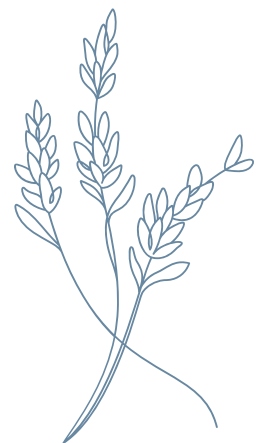
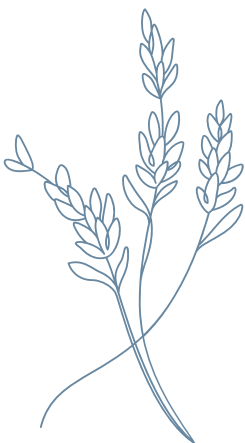
He opened his heart to Christ present in those oppressed by poverty and injustice.

All the children had such a brilliant time whilst also learning so much and it certainly was an experience Prep 3 will always remember.



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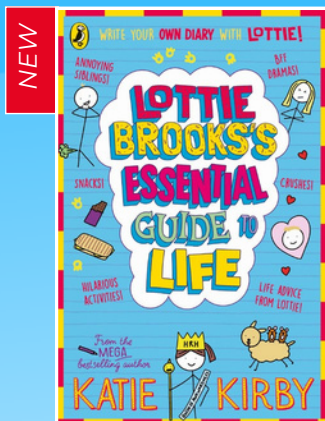
